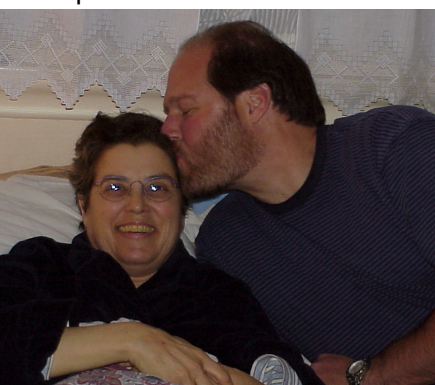




Tet and Brian found true love and danced in the New Year together.

Jessica teaches the "baby dinosaur" to dance at one of our parties. We can't understand how that dinosaur has held up so well after so many kid encounters!



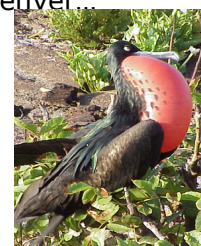

The noses are "in" with the nieces and Eric at Thanksgiving at our house..



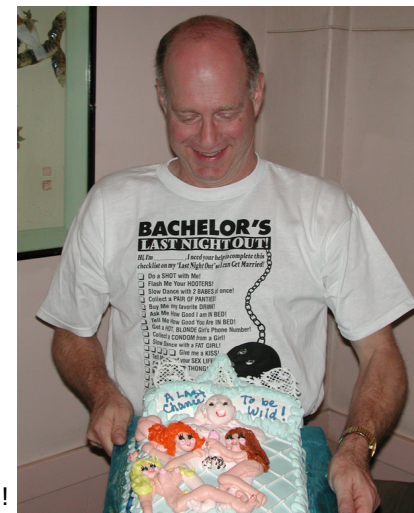
Caroline cooks up one of her extraordinary mushroom sautés.

We got to play with the munchkins. They are getting cuter all the time. And the Mom's aren't so bad either..



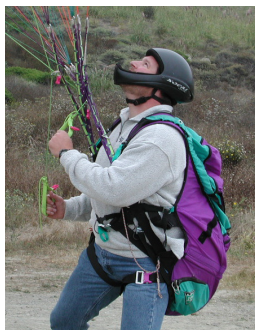
Our friend Linda visited us on her world wide odyssey. We took her to Natural Bridges to see the coast.
